QUESTION NO: 1

Your site review team reports that the new Product pages look good, but takes a long time to load.

What are two possible causes? Choose 2 answers

- A. images are being loaded without using Image styles to load correctly sized versions B. Internal Dynamic Page Cache is installed, but the reviewers are testing while logged in

QUESTION NO: 2
